The Federal Government of Nigeria has received financing for an amount of US\$ 98 million from the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) towards the cost of the Bilingual Education Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards payments under the contracts <sup>1</sup>for Civil Works (Construction of three (3) Units) of Bilingual Education Boarding Schools in Borno State.
2. The Universal Basic Education Commission now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for not more than **One (1) lot** for the construction of three (3) Units Boarding Schools, one each at the three (3) different locations in **Borno** State, planned to be executed within a period of seventeen months as contained in the **Special Procurement Notice** on the Daily Trust and The Guardian Newspapers of 7th and 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2021.
