The Federal Government of Nigeria has received financing for an amount of US\$ 98 million from the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) towards the cost of Bilingual Education Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards payments under the contracts for the Procurement of Instructional Materials and Supplies for the thirty (30) Bilingual Education Boarding Schools in the Nine (9) participating states.

- 4. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 1st November, 2023. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on 1st November, 2023, by 12.00 noon. However, a soft copy of the Financial Bid in an excel format shall be submitted in a flash drive enclosed in the hard copies of both Technical and Financial Bids.
